You can come into the surgery any time during opening hours and ask at reception for a new patient registration form.

Please note when bringing in your registration form to the surgery please **bring with you some ID** (passport or driving license and a utility bill) for proof of identification and address. This applies to all patients wanting to register who are aged 18 or over.

You can either fill the 'New patient application form' out there and then at reception or you can take it away with you.

Alternatively you can download and print a 'New patient application form' and take it completed to the surgery.

An appointment then needs to be booked with one of our Practice Nurses for a new patient check, this is just a general check for things like your blood pressure, weight etc.

Out of Area Patients.

For existing patients who move out of our practice boundary but who commute into Shrewsbury we may consider on an individual basis to agree to the patient having an “out of area registration”, this entitles the patient to be seen at the Practice but the patient will not be entitled to home visits.

Temporary Residents.

You are entitled to see a doctor anywhere in the United Kingdom if you are away from home and in need of medical help. We will be happy to see any relatives or friends who are staying with our registered patients and who require medical assistance.
