Afternoon Tea for Carers - 03.02.2016 at 2:30

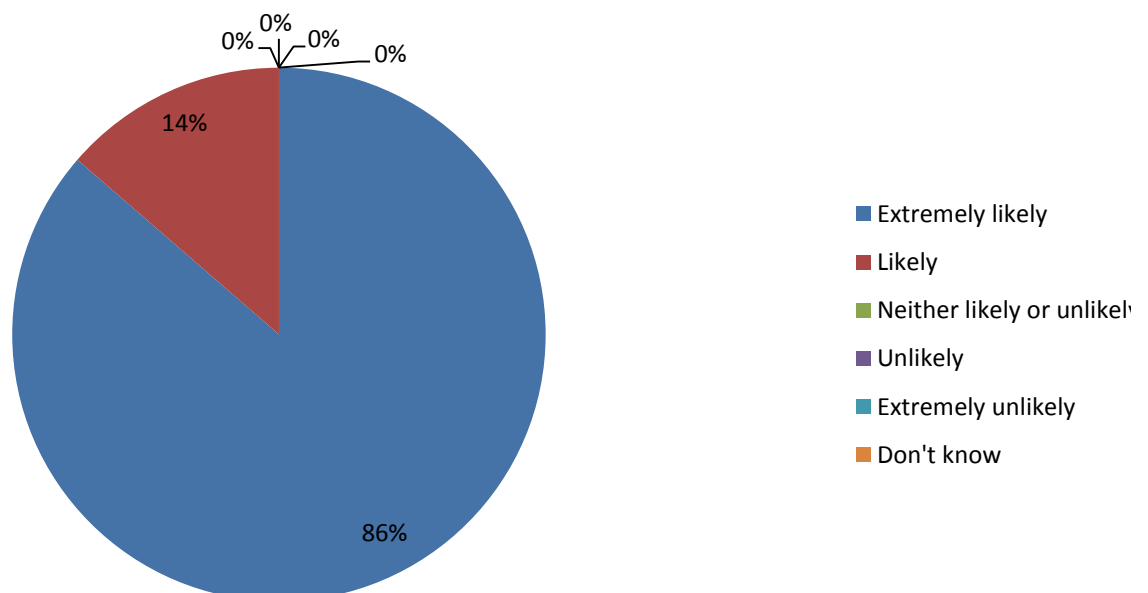
Do you look after a family member, spouse or partner who is ill, frail or has a disability?
